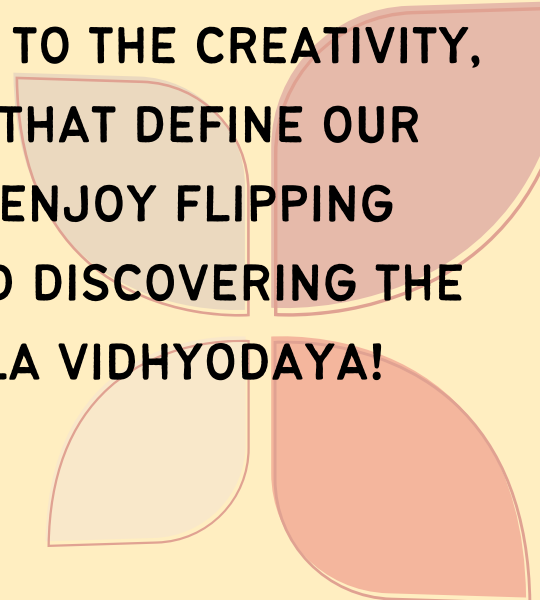

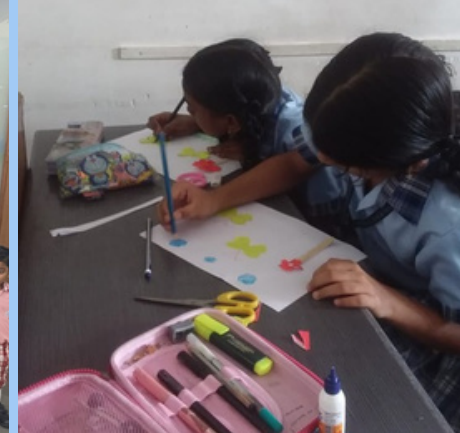

INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

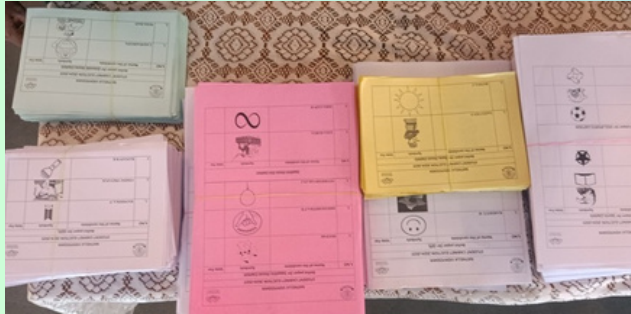
